UMass approved Accordia Partners to develop the 20-acre Bayside Expo Center site, which could yield up to 3.5 million square feet of new mixed-use waterfront development. Galvin will stress environmental resiliency, and envisions a walkway to the shore running across the development.

Accordia and a capital partner are paying \$235 million for the site's ground lease located at 200 Mount Vernon St. in Dorchester. The site is currently used as surface parking lots.
