• **SNAP/Food Stamps:** The **Greater Boston Food Bank (GBFB)** can help neighbors apply for SNAP/Food Stamp benefits.

**Please Note:** During this pandemic, all households who would normally qualify for the minimum monthly SNAP benefit (\$16 per two person household) would actually receive the maximum monthly SNAP benefit (\$374 per two person household.)
